## Mission

Children's Aid's Wagon Road Camp has a mission to provide the best summer fun possible. Working with a diverse group of kids, we build friendships, inspire creativity, and encourage growth.

## Facilities

Wagon Road Camp is located on 52 beautiful wooded acres in Chappaqua, NY, about 35 miles north of New York City. The property features:

- Two heated outdoor swimming pools
- Athletic facilities for basketball, baseball, soccer, volleyball, and other field games
- Adventure ropes course
- Riding corrals for horsemanship
- Nine buildings that provide indoor space for rainy day activities
- An air-conditioned infirmary
- Trails through 30 acres of woods and marshland

## Program

Campers are grouped by age, with a head counselor and assistant counselor supervising each group. The counselors engage campers in group projects and recreational activities. We also provide an array of activities run by specialists with expertise in each area.

### Activities

- Arts and crafts
- Adventure ropes course
- Adventure team building
- Dance, music, and drama
- Cooking
- Horsemanship
- Team sports and athletics

Swimming is offered daily, and each camper receives a swim lesson every other day. As Wagon Road serves a diverse group of children and employs a diverse staff, the program provides a rich multicultural experience.

## Camp Staff

Counselors and specialists are recruited from both NYC and Westchester. They are selected for their childcare and camp experience, special skills, and training. They are supervised by experienced professionals who make up camp's administration.

The water front director, two water safety instructors, and six lifeguards supervise free swim and provide progressive swim instruction to campers grouped by ability.

A registered nurse and health aid staff our infirmary.

## Transportation

Transportation from Manhattan is available by chartered, air-conditioned buses from designated Children's Aid community centers.

## Extended Hours

In order to better serve working parents, extended hours are offered until 6:00 p.m. at our Centers in Manhattan and the Bronx. For those who can pick up or drop off their children at the camp, extended hours are offered from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.. During extended hours, campers are supervised by camp staff and administrators and are provided with recreation activities.
